6th Programme on Off-Farm Development

The NBSC organized the 6th Programme on Off-farm Development for officers in Grades A, B and C from 18 to 22 December 2017. The programme was specially designed in the backdrop of introduction of policy changes in areas such as establishment of OFPOs, cluster development, etc.



Shri Amalorpavanathan, DMD inaugurated the programme through Video Conferencing. During his keynote address, he stressed that NABARD has since its inception given great emphasis on developing the non-farm sector in keeping with its mandate for facilitating credit flow for promotion and development of agriculture, cottage and village industries. He observed that over the years the focus has shifted from NFS to other areas. He extolled the officers to think of means to increase the income of artisans through value addition, technology improvements, design, access to market, skill development, brand building, etc

He discussed the Changing Paradigms of Development Management and traced the changes in enterprise development in the Indian Economy on account of policy changes since 1990's, factors that make enterprises successful, role of Development Practitioners and Local Implementers and the way ahead.
