

Training Programme on Climate change Adaptation and Mitigation at Chandigarh by NBSC, Lucknow : 23 to 25 August 2017

The captioned on-location training programme was conducted at Chandigarh from 23 to 25 August 2017 for Grade-A/B/C officers of NABARD. Twenty four participants from 22 Regional Offices/Head Office Departments of NABARD participated in the programme. The training programme was inaugurated by Shri Deepak Kumar, Chief General Manager, Punjab Regional Office. During the programme sessions were handled by the Faculty Members of NBSC as also by the officials from the Punjab State Council of Science and Technology and the Punjab RO. Dr. P J Ranjith, Principal graced the valedictory function. Dr. P J Ranjith also guided the group discussions on the last day, addressed the trainees and also interacted with Dr. A S Nanda, Vice chancellor of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (GADVASU), Ludhiana.

Besides class room sessions, there was one day field visit to GADVASU, Ludhiana, which is one of the Executing Agencies for the Climate Change adaptation project viz. “Towards Climate Resilient Livestock Production System in Punjab”. The project has been sanctioned under the NAFCC to the Punjab State Council of Science and Technology with a total outlay of Rs.17.40 crores. During the course of the field visit the trainees visited dairy units, climate resilient dairy sheds, fisheries and poultry units. The field visit as also the programme as a whole has been successful in clarifying the concepts pertaining to Climate Change adaptation projects. Shri V. K.
